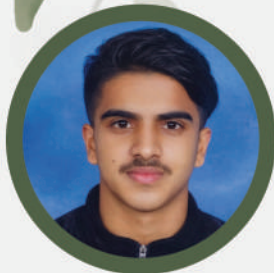

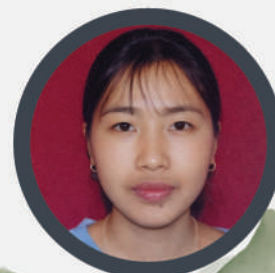

AWARENESS PROGRAM ON SEXUAL ABUSE



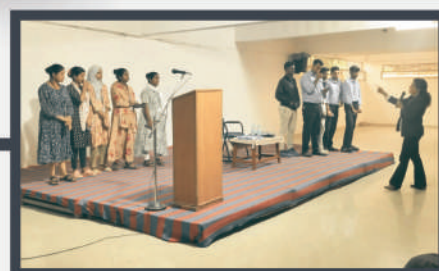
On 25th August 2025, an awareness session for girls was conducted by Oasis India, empowering students with safety knowledge.

MISSION SUNDAY FOOD FEST



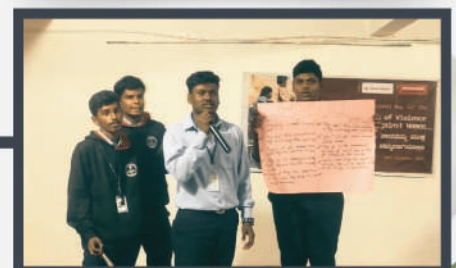
On 16th November 2025, SJIS students participated in the Mission Sunday Food Fest at St. Joseph's Church, contributing proceeds to mission activities.

FREE DENTAL CAMP



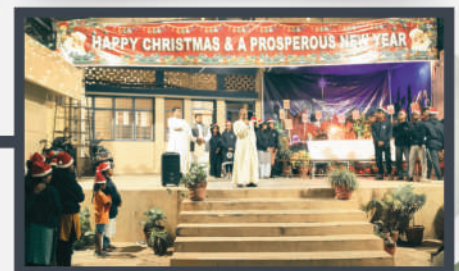
On 8th December 2025, a Free Dental Camp was conducted by RV Dental College, providing oral health check-ups and guidance.

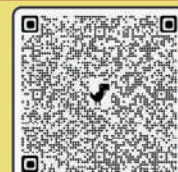
